



#### Cicero United Methodist Church Logo Design Challenge

Cicero UMC' Long-Rane Planning Team has been working hard to look into our future and make some new plans. Recently the Administrative Council has approved a new Vision and Mission Statement and a church-wide set of Core Values which will help speak to our community, guide development of programs and set our spiritual direction. You will begin to see changes in signage, messaging and the overall look around the church as we roll out these statements of belief. Our common Vision is that Love Grows Here!

**NOW WE NEED YOUR HELP!** Our Vision Statement needs a logo – a visual representation of the phrase Love Grows Here that will help direct our congregation and speak to our community as they look to us for examples of faith in action and God's grace in all things.

Each May it is a blessing to host an intergenerational gathering to celebrate Our Golden Christians who have worshipped and praised God sharing GOD'S LOVE and inspiring everyone whose life they touch to follow Jesus and spread GOD'S LOVE!

The Youth Group and their leaders, Confirmands and their mentors, share their LOVE by serving meals and beverages to our guests; by expertly preparing strawberry sundaes that they learned to make when they previously shared GOD'S LOVE on their mission trip to Virginia; by vacuuming and cleaning; by returning furniture to classrooms and storage at the end of the luncheon.

The technology team generously shared their time and LOVE by preparing slides; by providing sound and assisting in a variety of ways when they were not needed to control the technology board!

Sunday School children shared their LOVE by helping to set up for the luncheon, by assisting during the luncheon and using their God-given talents to entertain guests by playing in the chime choir, singing in the children's choir and playing instruments during the game!

Our hearts were full after the Chime Choir played "Tell Me the Stories of Jesus" and we asked guests to share their favorite stories of Jesus with people at their table! The room was just buzzing! LOVE WAS GROWING!

Then the children's choir was introduced and sang "Oh How I Love Jesus" And the LOVE OF JESUS was passed around the room, until EVERYONE was asked, "Everyone, do you LOVE Jesus?" And they responded, "Yes, I LOVE Jesus?" Then they were asked, "Why do you LOVE Jesus" and everyone sang, "BECAUSE HE FIRST LOVED ME!" LOVE CONTINUED TO BLOSSOM AND GROW!

Everyone was asked to share the person who taught them about how much JESUS LOVED THEM. The children decided it was their Children's Choir director who taught them to sing, "JESUS LOVES THE LITTLE CHILDREN" What a beautiful message of LOVE shared by our youngest children! After sharing their song, Rev. Niles said grace.

And the Kitchen staff under the direction of an amazing Sunday School teacher who shared her LOVE working many days to adjust her delicious chicken and biscuit family recipe to feed over 175 guests, served a meal enjoyed by everyone! Appetites satisfied LOVE KEPT GROWING IN OUR HEARTS!

After the meal, the room was buzzing once again as everyone played and intergenerational game which included 10 multiple choice questions identifying Parables of Jesus, 5 fill in the blank scriptures about Jesus, and 3 Name that Tune songs played by four talented Sunday School students! The guests that sat with Pastor Niles Family were ecstatic because they got every answer correct!

While dessert was being served, we pointed out the other themes that another Sunday School teacher worked so hard to create and with which she decorated the room! One of the themes was KEEP WRITING GOD'S STORY OF LOVE! Perhaps the highlight of the Luncheon was when June Stevenson, a precious and talented Golden Christian, shared her book as she kept writing GOD'S STORY OF LOVE TO SHARE WITH HER FAMILY!

Each guest received a gift bag sharing God's Love and Our Love that contained a copy of "Footprints in the Sand," a Little Jesus figurine that says I LOVE YOU, and a fuzzy pom-pom! A gift that keeps on giving – a gift to pass on and to share GOD'S LOVE WITH OTHERS!
